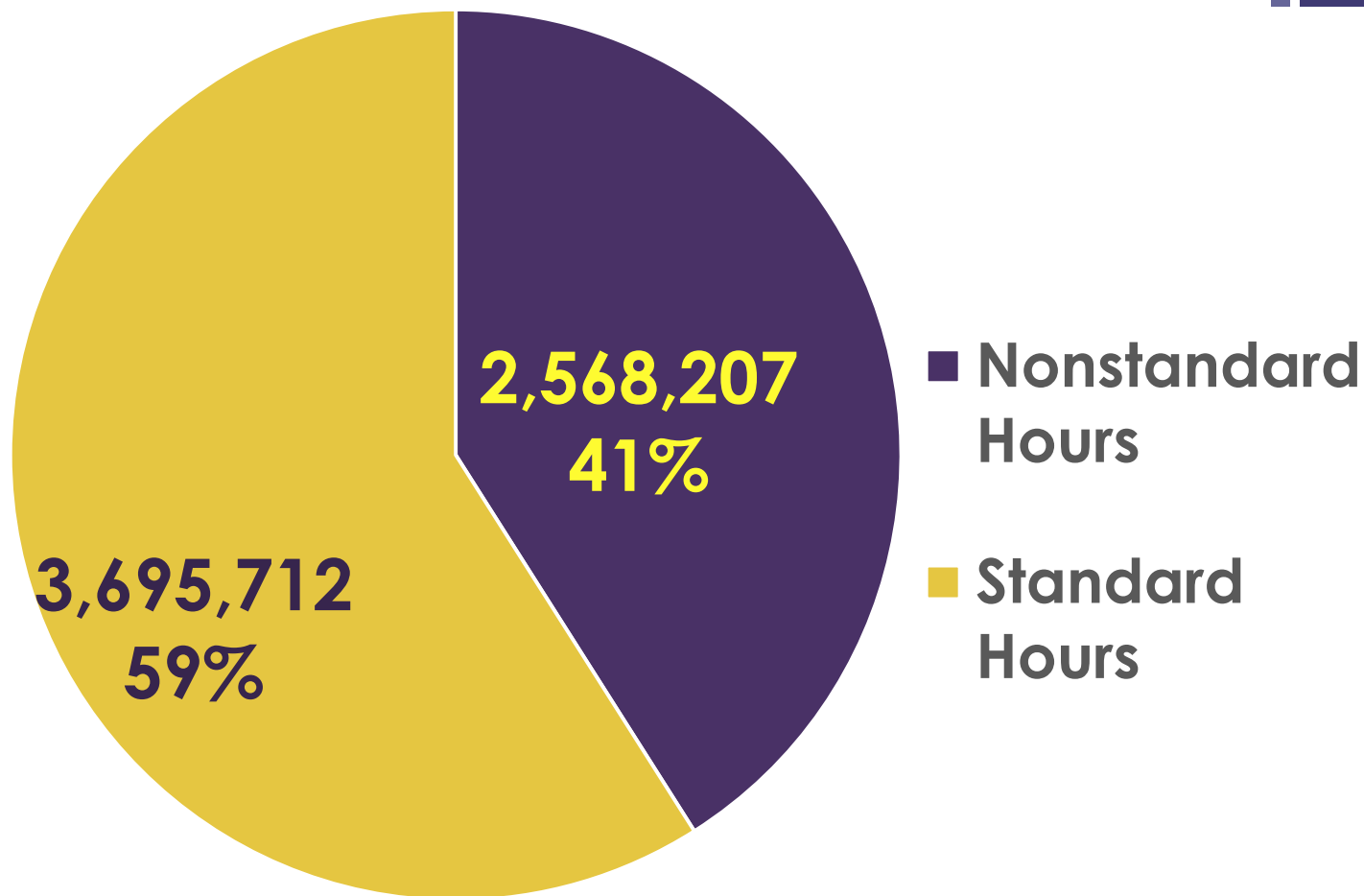

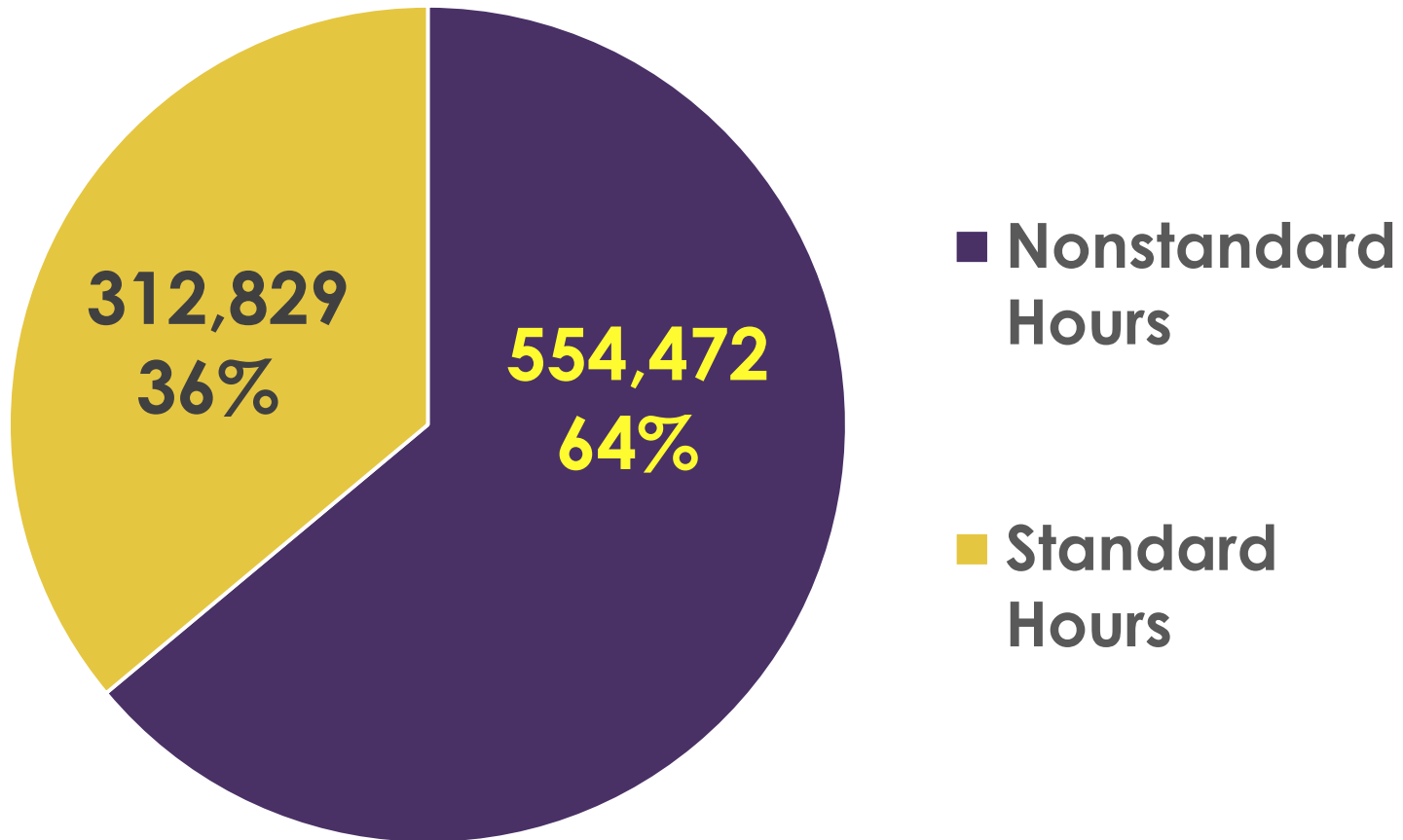
Illinois Employees with Standard & Nonstandard Work Schedules

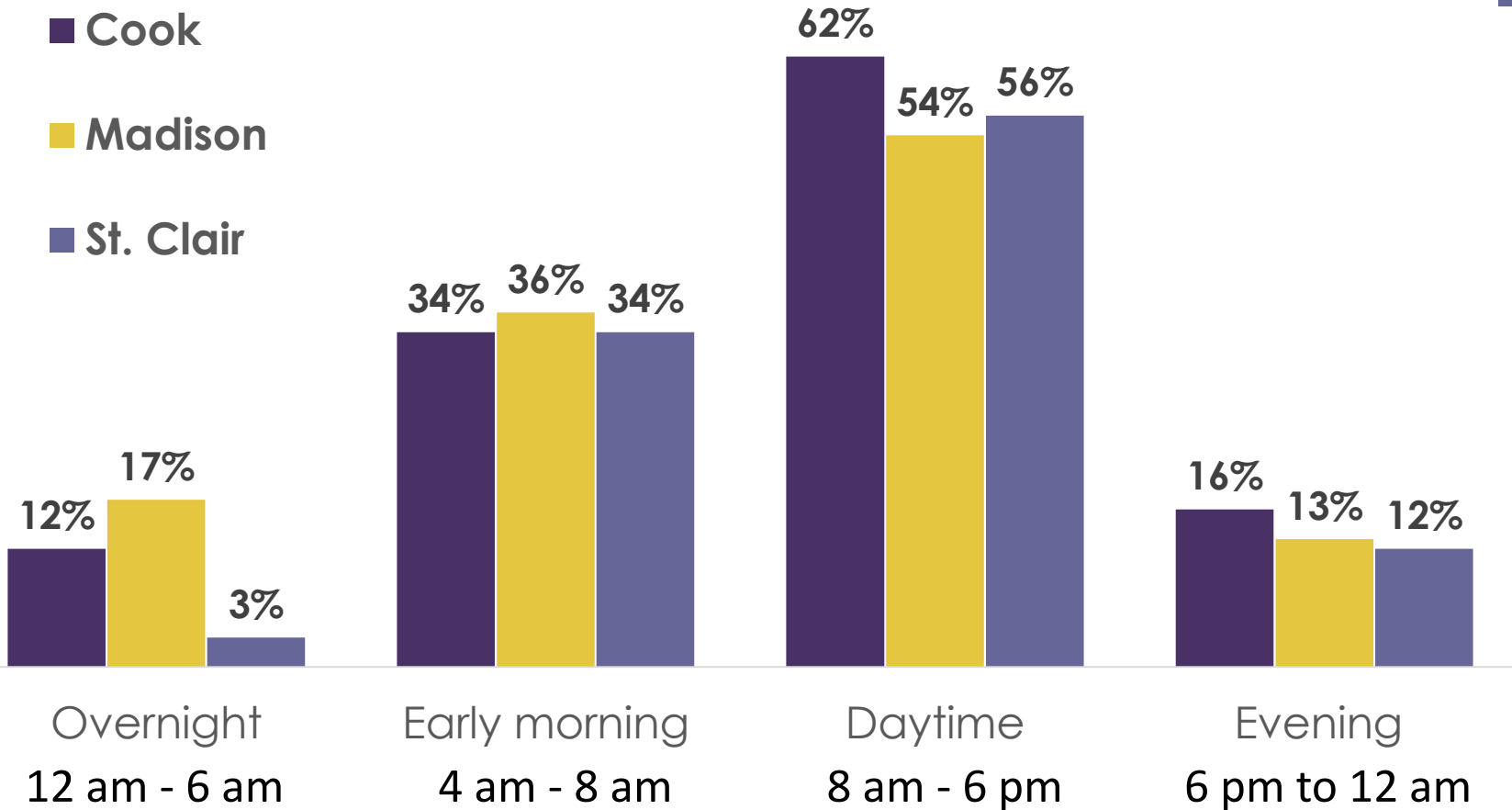
Percent of Children under Age 6 Whose Single or Two Parents Work –

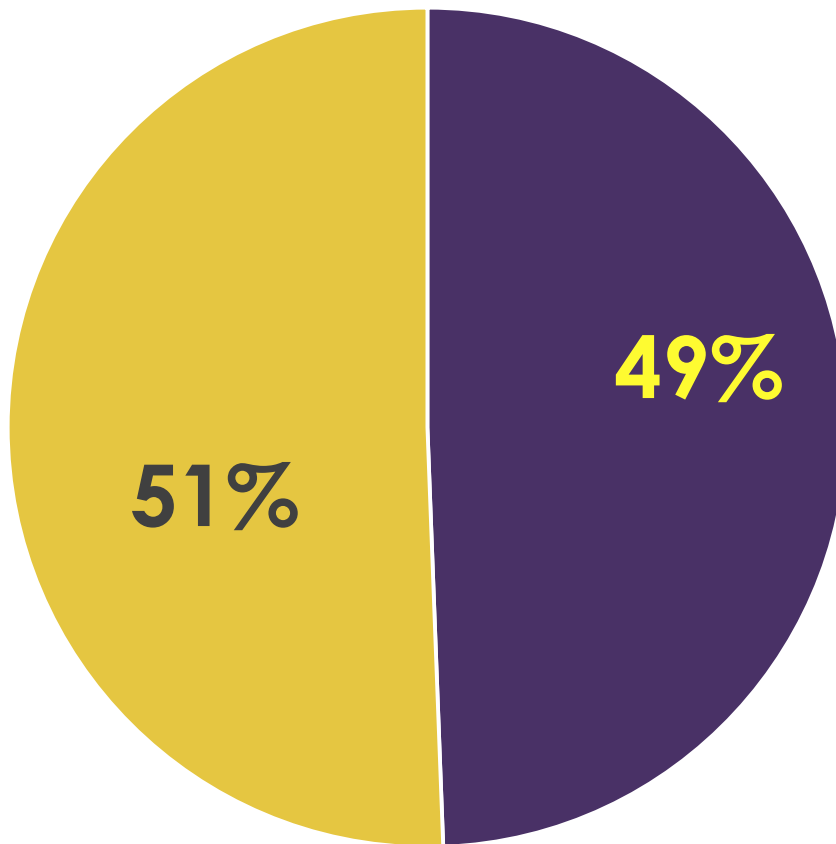




How Many Employed CCAP Parents Have Nonstandard Works Schedules?



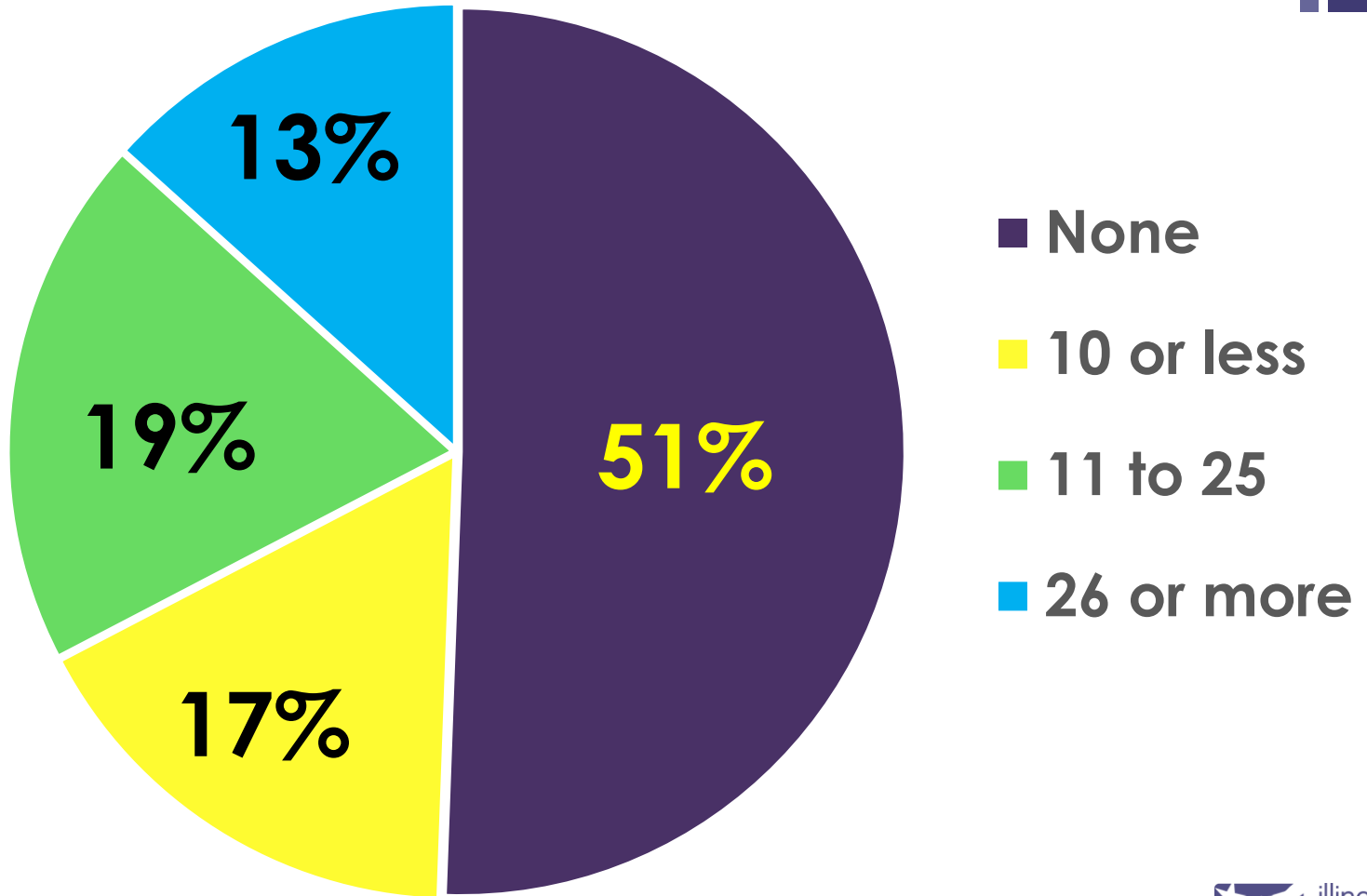

How Many Nonstandard Hours Do CCAP Parents Work Each Week?

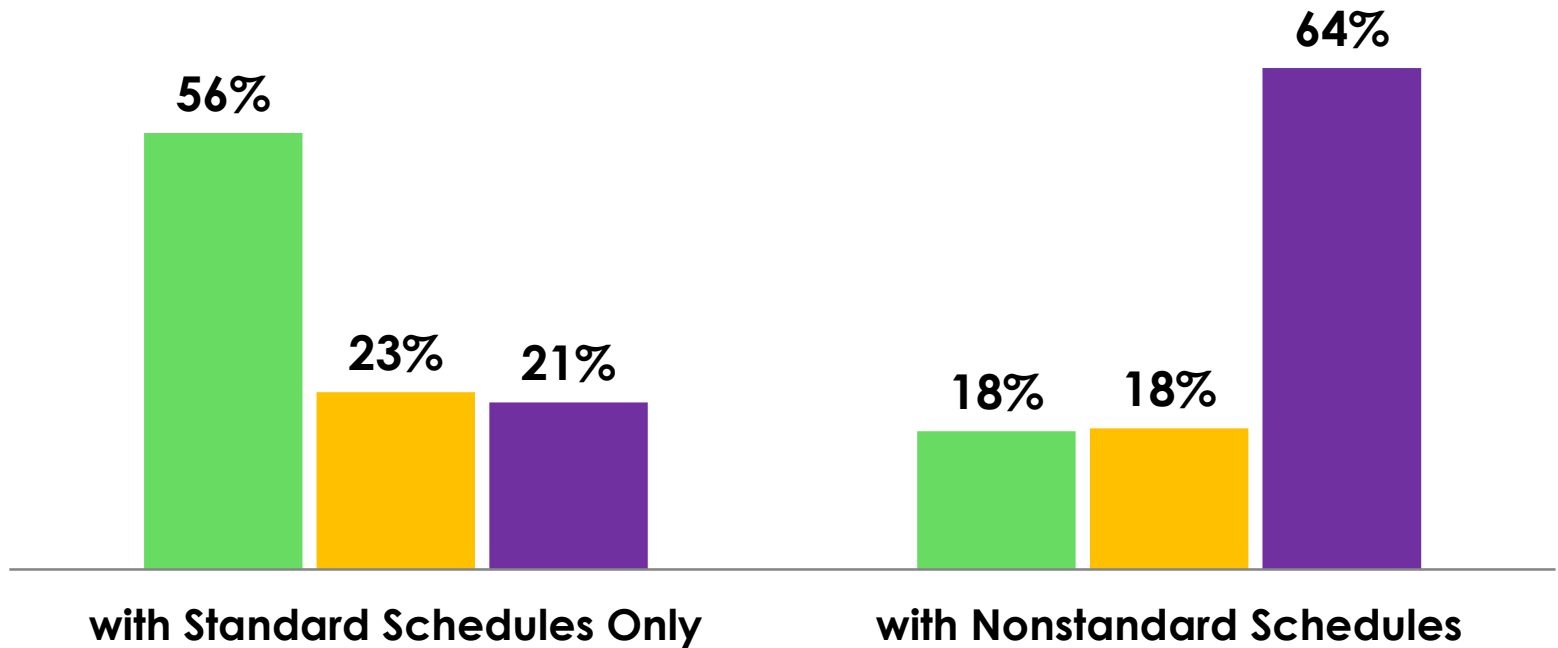




Types of Child Care Used by CCAP Parents *by Work Schedule*
